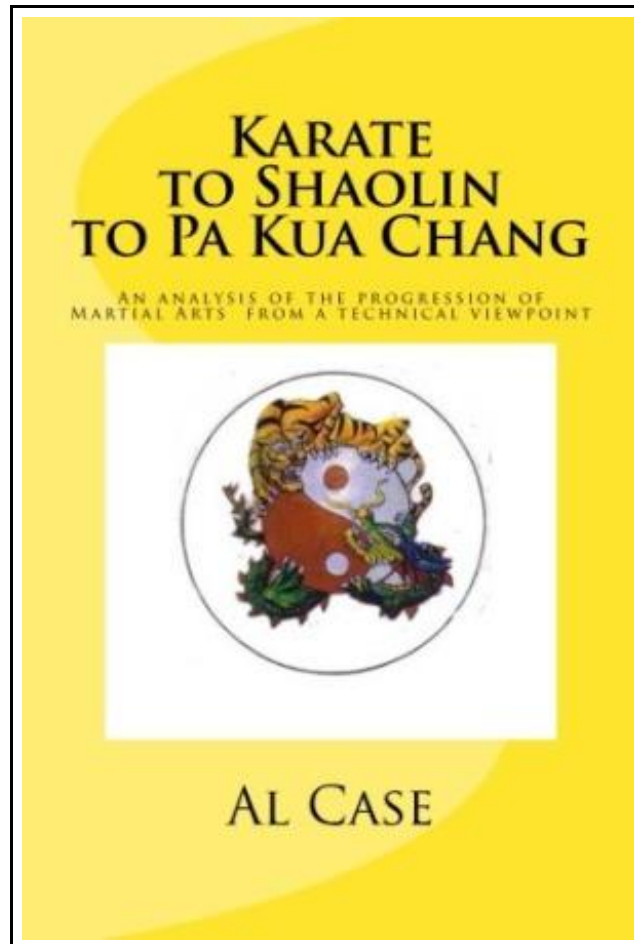

He has studied Kenpo, Karate, Wing chun, Aikido, Tai Chi Chuan, Northern Shaolin, Southern Shaolin, Pa Kua Chang, various weapons, and more.
