We tend to think of the American Revolution as a Massachusetts-based event orchestrated by Virginians, but in fact the war took place mostly in New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania. In this attempt to uncover the often bizarre ways that we commemorate our history, the author of *The Thoreau You Don't Know* visits the down-home reenactment of Washington's crossing of the Delaware, meets a man who was arrested for using a colonial submarine, and recounts the life and death of Philip Freneau, the first (and not so great) poet of American Independence.
