



Boulders Masonic Pioneers, 1867-1886: Members of Columbia Lodge No. 14, Boulder County, Colorado Territory

The Columbia Lodge No. 14 Ancient Free and Accepted Masons was formally established in the town of Columbia (now called Ward) in 1867. In 1868, the Columbia Lodge petitioned the Grand Lodge to move to Boulder. There was a contemporary lodge in Valmont that dissolved and many of the members of that lodge became members of the Columbia Lodge. Access to the early records of the Columbia Lodge was graciously granted to the Boulder Pioneers Project to help determine who the residents of Boulder County were before Colorado became a state in 1876. The Minute Books contain not only references to the on-going activities of the Columbia Lodge, but mentions members of the community who provided services to the lodge; members of the community who were in need and were helped by the lodge; Masons from this lodge and others who died in Boulder and whose funerals were conducted by the lodge; the establishment of a cemetery in the community part of which was run by the Columbia Lodge, part of which was sold to the Odd Fellows, part of which was reserved for...
