

The tongue-position for d(t) is much the same as that for z(s), except that actual contact is made by the tip of the tongue against the upper gums. The k in quite, kwait is pronounced with liprounding under the influence of the following w. A labiodental nasal consonant is sometimes used instead of m, when followed by f or v, as in comfort, k and mfat. n sometimes becomes m under the influence of a preceding labial, e. g. oupm for oup(a)n. VII. QUANTITY 195. All sounds may be continued during a shorter or longer period. For practical purposes it is sufficient to distinguish two or at most three degrees of quantity (long and short, or long, half-long and..
